The J. Frederick "Fritz" Wolf Vocal Scholarship

J. Frederick Wolf was a life-long Mansfield area resident. He was born April 22, 1914, and died March 11, 2005. He founded the Mansfield Choral Society in 1933, and was the Director of the volunteer community singing group for 56 years. Richland Academy is honored to be able to continue this legacy. This year the scholarship will be a one-time \$350 award.

Criteria for the Scholarship

An applicant for this award should be:

- A Current Voice Student (*Does not have to currently study at Richland Academy of the Arts*)
- Age 12+ (younger students may be considered with instructor recommendation.)
- Available to audition on Saturday, August 18, 2018, beginning at 10:30am (You will be contacted with your specific audition time)
- Applicants are required to sing one song from the Solo & Ensemble Junior or Senior High Vocal Solo Class A list (Whichever is age appropriate)

The Dr. Thomas H. Croghan Contemporary Music Scholarship

Dr. Croghan may have been born in Dayton, but he made his home in Mansfield. He was a practicing physician and an excellent jazz musician. In addition to being the founding President, he made numerous donations and was the driving force behind countless performances. He was a firm believer in the wonder and importance of jazz music and loved to encourage students. Richland Academy is honored to be able to continue this legacy. This year the scholarship will be a one-time \$350 award.

- A Current Contemporary Music/Jazz Student — instrumental or vocal (*Does not have to currently study at Richland Academy of the Arts*)
- Voice - Age 12+, Piano - Age 7+, Other Instruments - Age 10+ (younger students may be considered with instructor recommendation.)
- Available to audition on Saturday, August 18, 2018, beginning at 10:30am (You will be contacted with your specific audition time)
- Applicants are required to perform a well-known song (possibly from the American Songbook) from memory (solo or with accompaniment), and to improvise 4 choruses of F, G, or C blues.

These skills are designed to begin a solid foundation for students as they move onto advanced training in higher levels. Additionally children will improve their self-confidence by doing drills designed to help increase focus, power, speed and overall abilities. We will also learn sparring tactics and strategies while continuously reinforcing that Karate is used for self-defense only.
